

PECTORALIS MINOR: Key muscle of axilla. divide A-A into 3

ORIGIN:

- 3rd, 4th, 5th ribs near costochondral junction.

- Intervening fascia covering external intercostal muscle.

INSERTION:

medial & upper part of coracoid process.

NERVE SUPPLY

Medial pectoral nerve.

ACTION:

in punching



ACTION.

- moves the scapula forward. for punching
and survival
- depresses the tip of shoulder.
- raises ribs during ^{forced} inspiration
~~when scapula is not moving.~~

process**

**Origin:
third, fourth,
and fifth rib**
