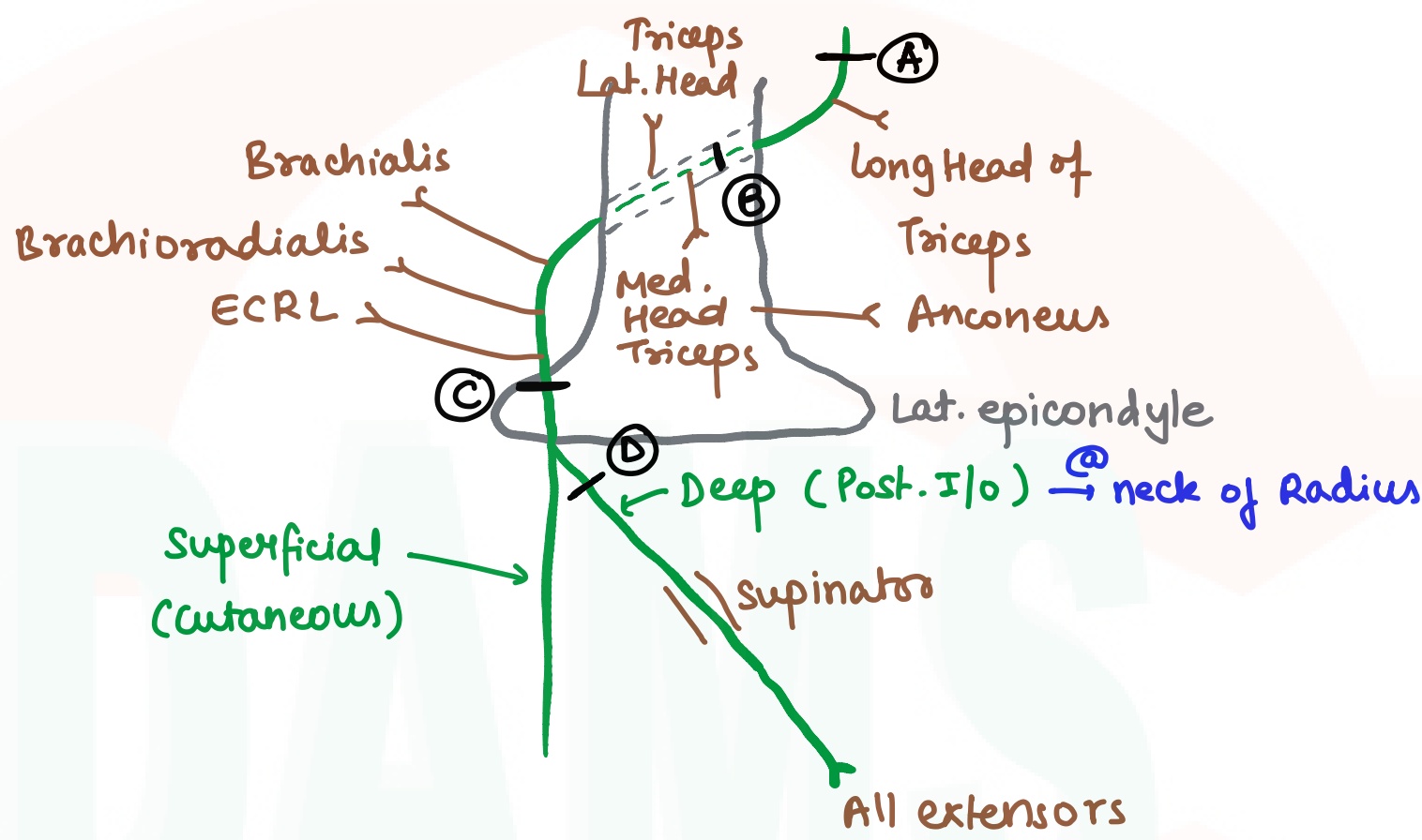


RADIAL NERVE



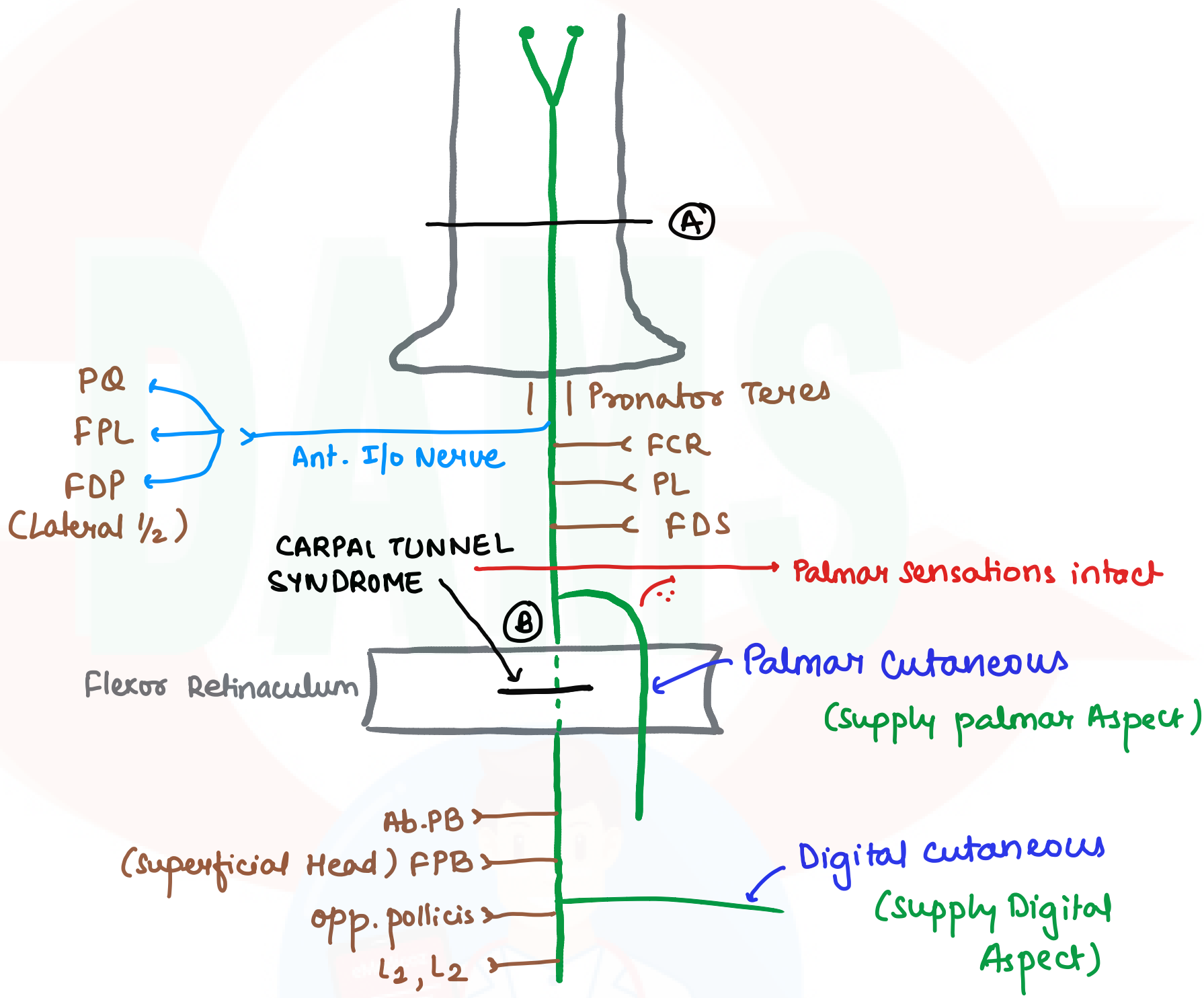
	Elbow	Wrist	MCP (finger)

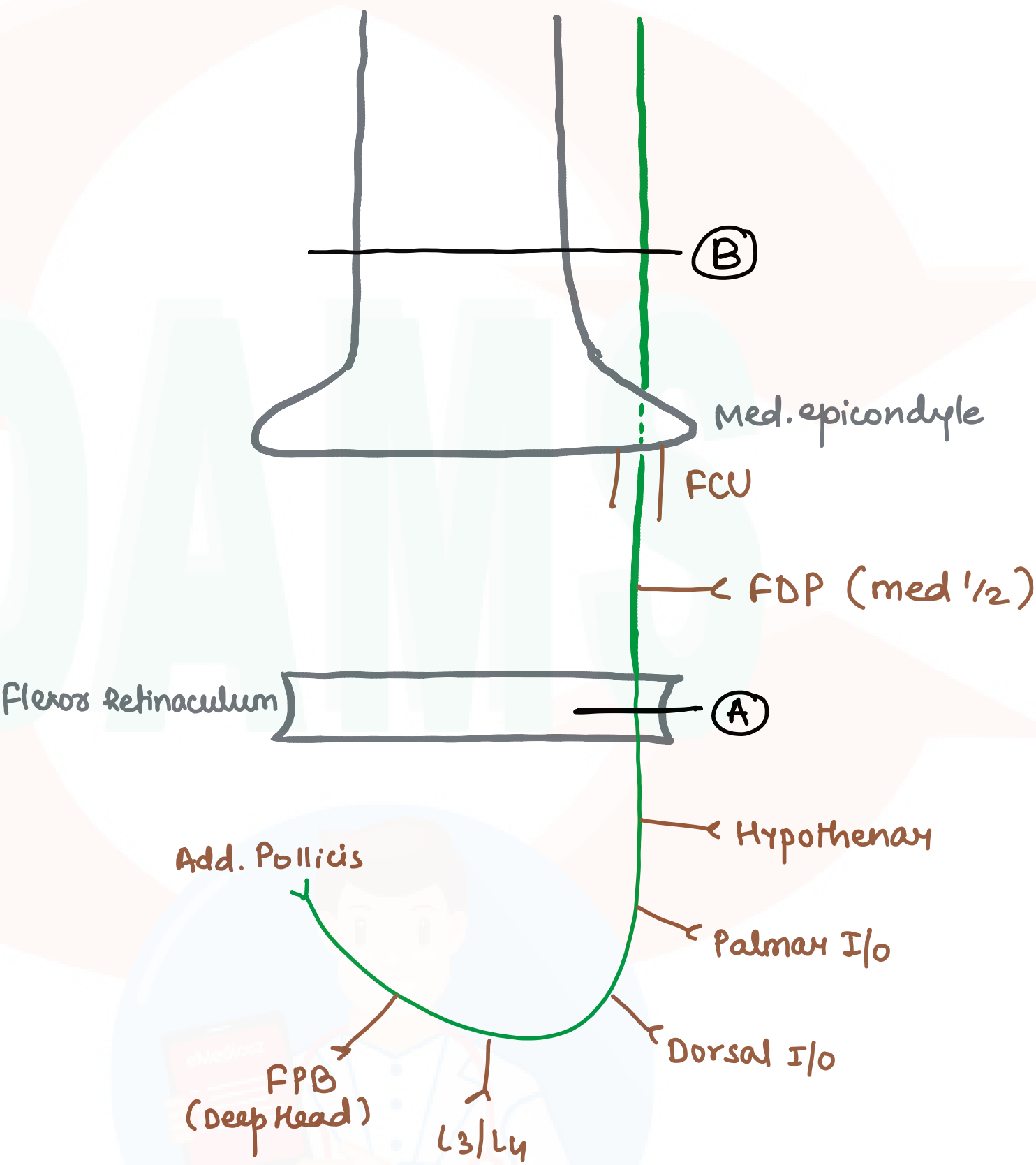

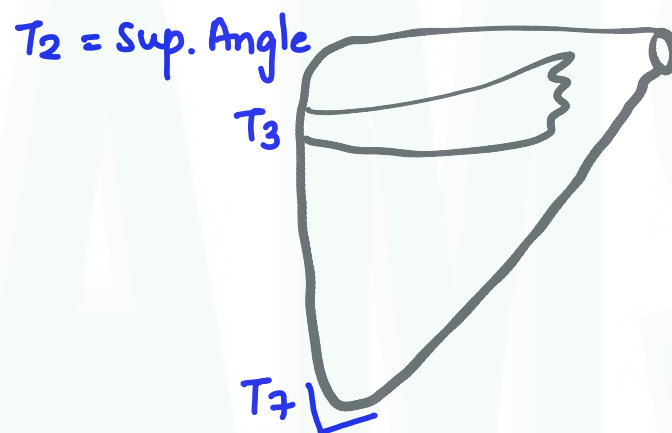
Q finger drop with no wrist drop is caused by lesion of :

↳ Post. T₁o nerve

Q Intracapsular but Extrasynovial is : → long head of biceps brachii

→ Clavicle (Mlc # Site = med. 3/5 Lat. 2/5) ← Grey 41e

Note) Coracoid process is palpable in infraclavicular fossa
