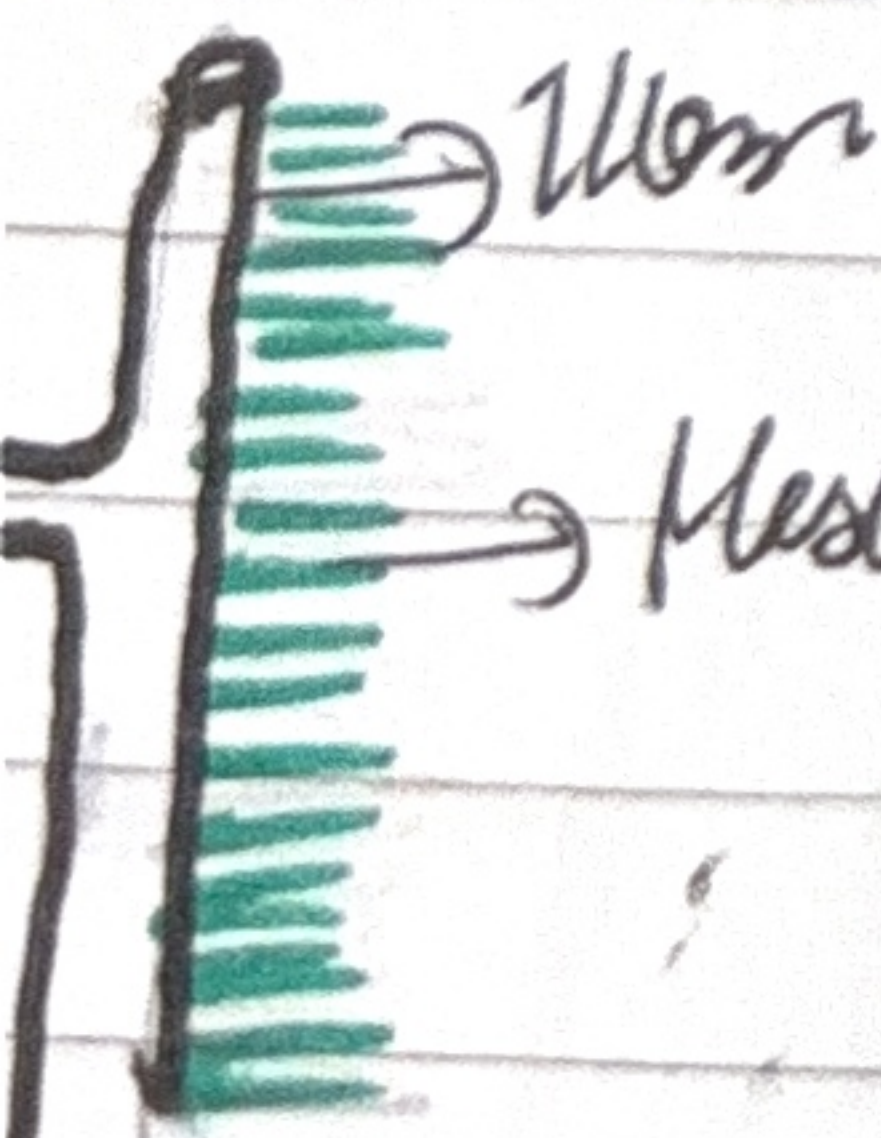

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UTERUS:

Axis:

Parts of uterus

Fundus: - free end of uterus

- lie above opening of uterine tube
- fertilized oocyte is usually implanted in posterior wall of fundus

Body: Ant Part is flat Related to urinary bladder

→ covered by peritoneum

→ form sup wall of uterovaginal pouch.

Post. surface is convex Related to terminal ileum

→ covered with peritoneum

→ form Ant wall of Rectovaginal pouch.

lateral body → Round & convex

- provide attachment to broad lig of uterus

uterine tube open into uterus of end of

this border

cervix - The cervix is lower cylindrical part of uterus

• lower part of cervix projects into Ant of vagina

divided into wall → supra vaginal
into → vaginal

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LIGAMENT OF UTERUS:

1) Peritoneal lig: they & peritoneal fold do not provide support to uterus.

⇒ Ant lig - consist of uterovaginal fold of peritoneum

⇒ Post lig - consist of uterovaginal fold.

⇒ Right of left broad lig - are fold of peritoneum which attaches uterus to lateral pelvic wall

2) Broad lig - 3 parts:

⇒ Ovary is attached to post layer of Broad lig through mesometrium

⇒ Part of broad lig lying b/w uterine tube & lig of ovary mesosalpinx

⇒ while part below the lig of ovary - mesometrium

Broad lig consist of:

• uterine ligament

• uterovaginal of ovarian

• Round lig of uterus - associated with round ligament

• lig of ovary - associated with suspensory ligament

• uterine vessel

• ovarian vessel

3) Transversal lig of uterus

• Round lig of uterus

• Transverse lig of uterus

• Uterosacral lig

ARTERIAL SUPPLY:

• chiefly - uterine Artery

• Pally - Ovarian Artery.

venous drainage → vein from uterus along lateral pelvic wall of uterus.

NERVE SUPPLY:

• Sympathetic nerve (T12-L1) - uterine contraction & vasoconstriction.

• Parasympathetic nerve (S2-S4) - uterine inhibition.
