

Study Your Way on CoreBTR

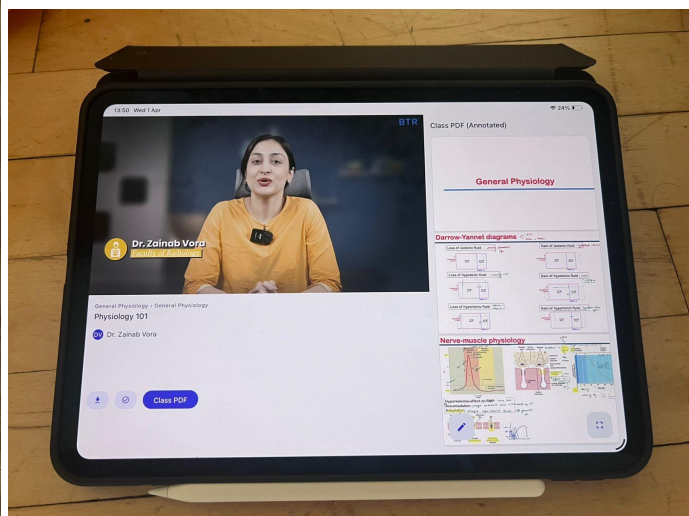
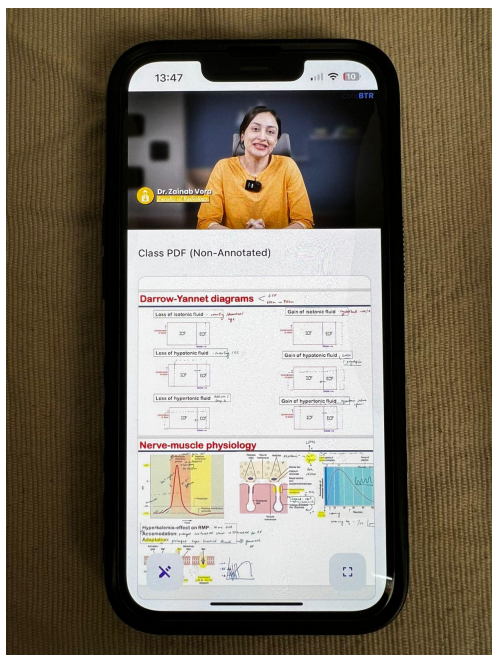
We built CoreBTR around one idea: your study setup should work for you, not the other way around. Whether you're on a phone during your commute or an iPad at your desk, the app is designed so you can watch video lectures and study notes PDFs on the same device — no second screen required, no juggling logins.

Watch + Study on One Device

The CoreBTR app lets you watch video lectures and view the Class PDF right below the video — all on the same screen. Scroll down while the lecture plays to follow along with the annotated or unannotated notes without leaving the app.

This works on your iPhone, iPad, Android phone, or Android tablet.

No second device needed, no switching between apps — the video and notes are together in one place, ready when you are.

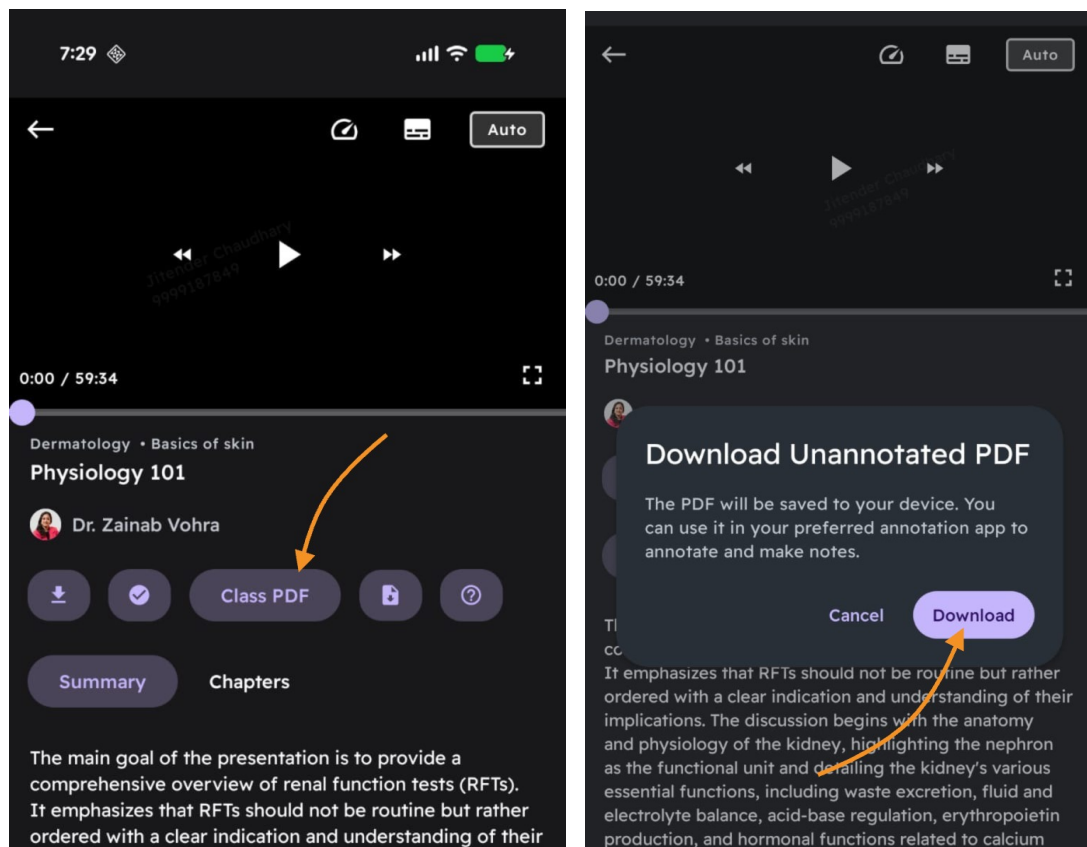


Download and Annotate PDFs Your Way

Each video lecture comes with a **Class PDF** section where you can view both the annotated and unannotated versions of the notes.

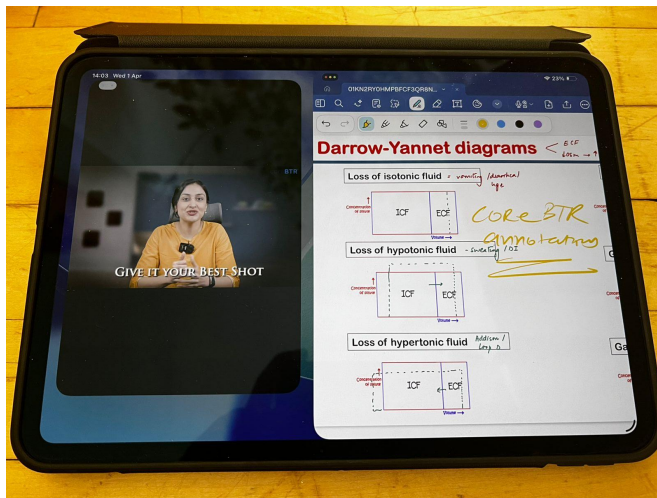
To take it a step further, tap the download icon to save the unannotated PDF directly to your device. You'll see a prompt confirming the download — tap **Download**, and the PDF is yours to use. *Launching soon on the CoreBTR app!*

Open it in your favorite annotation app — GoodNotes, Notability, or any PDF viewer you prefer — and annotate while the lecture plays.

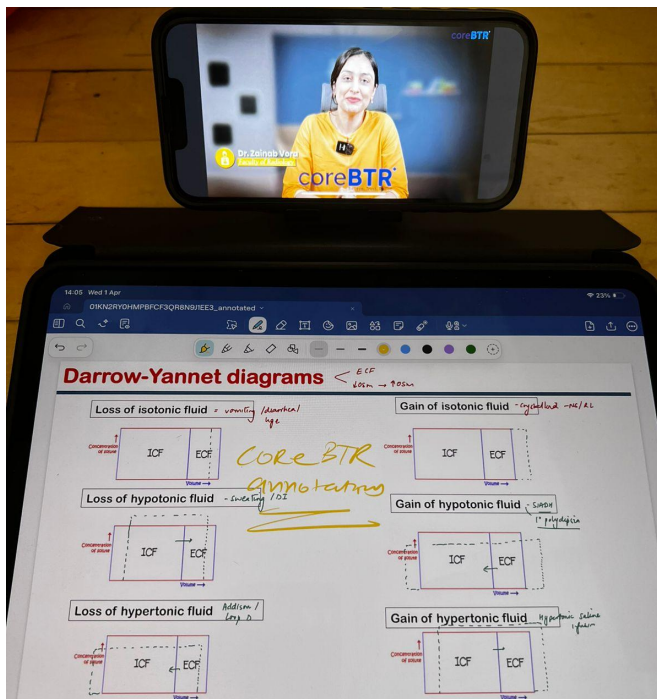


There are two ways to do this:

On Device that supports Split Screen — On iPad, use Split Screen to run CoreBTR on one half and your annotation app on the other. Watch the lecture on one side, annotate on the other — all on a single device, no other device needed.



Across two linked devices — Watch the video on your phone and annotate the downloaded PDF on your iPad (or tablet) using your preferred annotation app. Prop your phone up, follow the lecture, and make your notes on the bigger screen.



This gives you full flexibility to study the way that suits you best.

Watch Videos + Review Tests at the Same Time

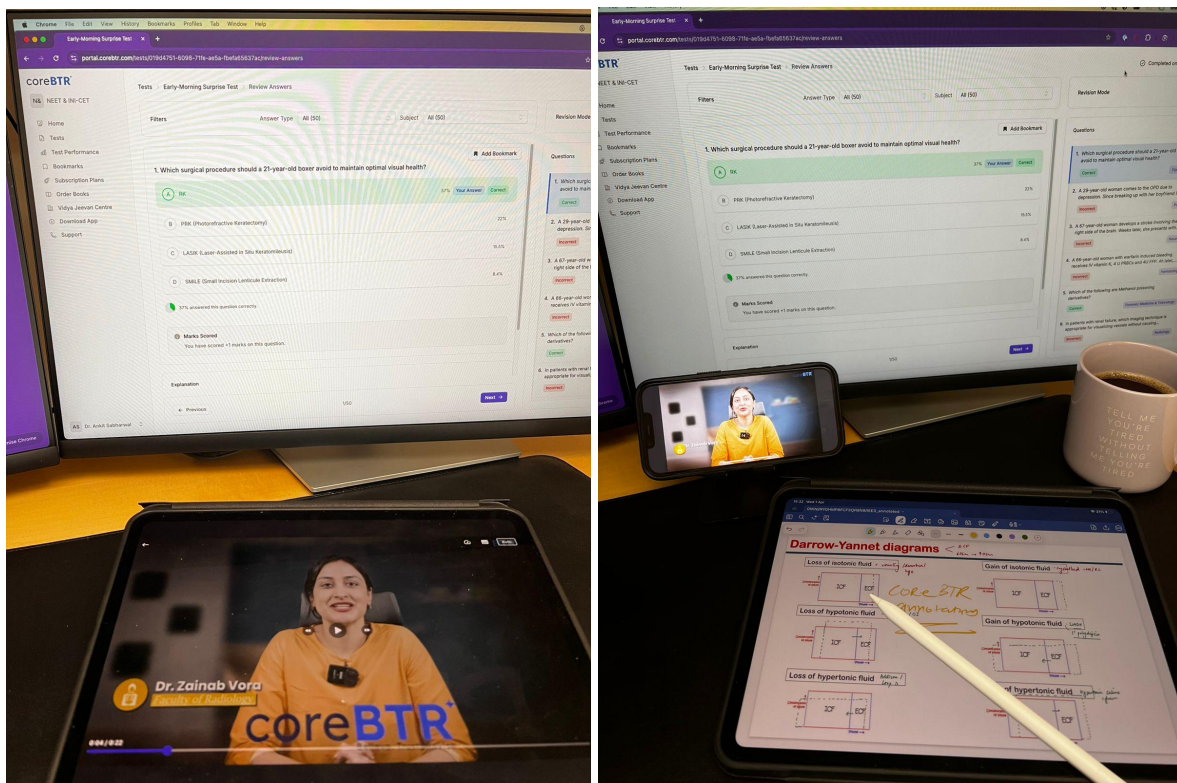
You can take your study setup a step further. The CoreBTR web portal (portal.corebtr.com) runs completely independently from the app — logging in on the web portal does not affect your app session or count toward your linked devices.

The web portal gives you full access to review your tests, analyze each question, and manage your bookmarks. It also features India's most advanced real-life mock exam interface, designed to replicate the actual exam environment so you're fully prepared for the day that matters most.

Here are two study setups that make the most of this:

Video on your phone or tablet + Test review on your laptop — Watch Dr. Zainab's video lecture on the CoreBTR app while reviewing your test answers and explanations on the web portal side by side. Revisit the questions you got wrong while the relevant lecture plays right next to you.

The full setup — Watch the video on your phone, review your test on the web portal on your laptop, and annotate PDFs on your tablet — all at the same time. Three screens, one study session, zero conflicts between sessions.



Our Device Policy — and Why It's Set Up This Way

CoreBTR allows you to link up to two devices to your account — for example, your phone and your tablet. You can use either device anytime, one at a time.

Here's what that means in practice:

- Two linked devices per account. Most students use a phone and a tablet. Link both, and you're set.
- One active session at a time. If you switch from your phone to your tablet, the phone session ends automatically. This is how most streaming and learning platforms work — it keeps things simple and secure.
- Linked devices are permanent. Once a device is linked, it can't be swapped out. This protects your account — if someone else got your credentials, they can't silently replace your device with theirs.

Why this policy exists: Every restriction here is in place to protect your access, not limit it. Device linking ensures that your subscription stays yours. The session limit means no one else can use your account at the same time. And monitoring for unusual activity helps us catch unauthorized access before it affects you.

We've kept the limits generous for genuine personal use — two registered devices and the freedom to switch between them covers how most students actually study. The goal is a platform where the content stays secure, the experience stays fast, and your account stays safe.

A few things to keep in mind:

- Sharing your login credentials puts your account at risk and is against the policy
- Screen recording, mirroring, and use on rooted or jailbroken devices are not permitted.

These measures exist so we can continue delivering high-quality content exclusively to the students who subscribe. A secure platform means better content, consistent updates, and a reliable experience for everyone.
