Inspection

- 1) Preauricular

- 5) Diagram
- 6) Middle ear mucosa (congested)

Palpation

- 1) Mastoid Tenderness (complicated CSOM)
- 2) Tragal Tenderness (folliculitis in canal)

Functional Examination

- 1) Rinne's test
- 2) Weber's test
- 3) Fistula test (Nystagmus)
- 4) Absolute Bone Conduction test (same as that of examiner)
- 5) Facial Nerve
- 6) Visual Field.

Examination of Eye

- Inter canthal distance
- Vision

Examination of Oral Cavity and Throat

- 1) Lips
 - 2) Gums and teeth
 - 3) Gingivobuccal sulcus
 - 4) Buccal Mucosa.
 - 5) Tongue and floor of mouth.
 - 6) Palate.
 - 7) Tonsils and pillars
 - 8) Posterior pharyngeal wall
- } congestion, edematous.

Examination of Neck

- 1) Visible scars, sinuses, dilated Veins
- 2) Visible palpation
- 3) Lymph nodes : Mental, submandibular, jugular, pretracheal, paratracheal etc..
